



CLUB BY-LAWS

SOUTH SHORE SWIMMING CLUB INC

Date ratified: 27th October 2019

1. GENERAL

1.1 Club Colours

The colours of the Club shall be black, red, and gold, subject to the approval of Swimming WA.

2. MEMBERSHIP

2.1 Ordinary Membership Categories

2.1.1 Swimming – Senior Competitive

Any person 16 years or over who actively participates in competition swimming activities of the Club and is registered with Swimming WA under the appropriate category.

2.1.2 Parent / Guardian

Parents or legal guardians of a Swimmer – Age Competitive of the Club will be accepted as a Parent / Guardian Member. Only one (1) Parent / Guardian vote is allowed per family. Families who have both Senior Competitive member(s) and Age Competitive member(s) retain the voting rights of a Parent / Guardian Member.

2.1.3 Head Coach

A Head Coach member may be appointed by the Committee. Eligible to vote at Committee and general meetings of the Club.

2.1.4 Coach

Persons actively engaged in a Coaching role at the Club will be accepted as Coach Members.

2.1.5 Technical Official

Persons actively engaged as Technical Officials at the Club will be accepted as Technical Official Members.

2.1.6 Ordinary

Any Ordinary member who does not meet the requirements of By-laws 2.1.1, 2.1.2, or 2.1.3 is designated an Ordinary member.

2.1.7 Nominated Membership Positions – Life and Swimming Life

Refer to Rules, Section 5.5.

Life and Swimming Life Members shall be issued with a club badge and will be entitled to free membership and free admission to events and functions of the Club.

2.2 Associate Membership Categories

2.2.1 Swimming – Age Competitive

Any person under 16 years who actively participates in competition swimming activities of the Club and is registered with Swimming WA under the appropriate category.

2.2.2 Nominated Membership Positions - Honorary

Refer to Rules, Section 5.5.

3. CONSULTATIVE COMMITTEE

3.1 Consultative Committee Members

A Consultative Committee shall consist of:

- (a) Centre Manager of Melville LeisureFit Booragoon
- (b) Program Co-ordinator of Melville LeisureFit Booragoon
- (c) Head Coach of the Club
- (d) President of the Club
- (e) Vice President(s) of the Club

- 4.2 The Consultative Committee will meet at least three (3) times each year, or as determined by the Consultative Committee, to discuss policy and directional settings for the Club to convey to the Committee.
- 4.3 The Consultative Committee will not be involved in the day to day decision making powers of the Club. The Consultative Committee will liaise between the Club and Melville LeisureFit Booragoon as required.
